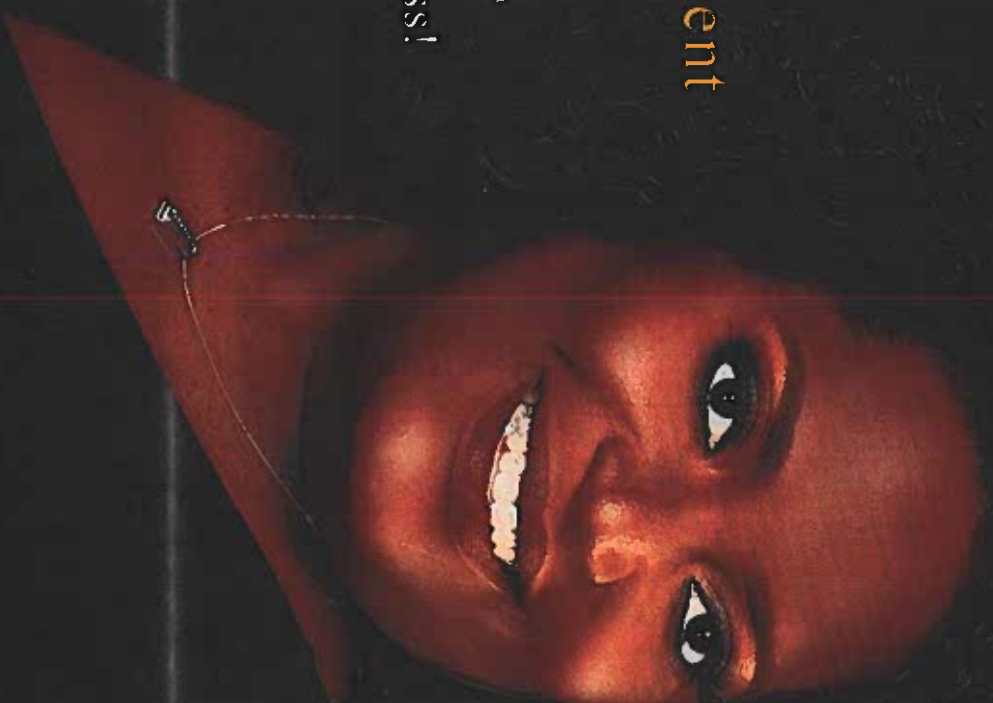

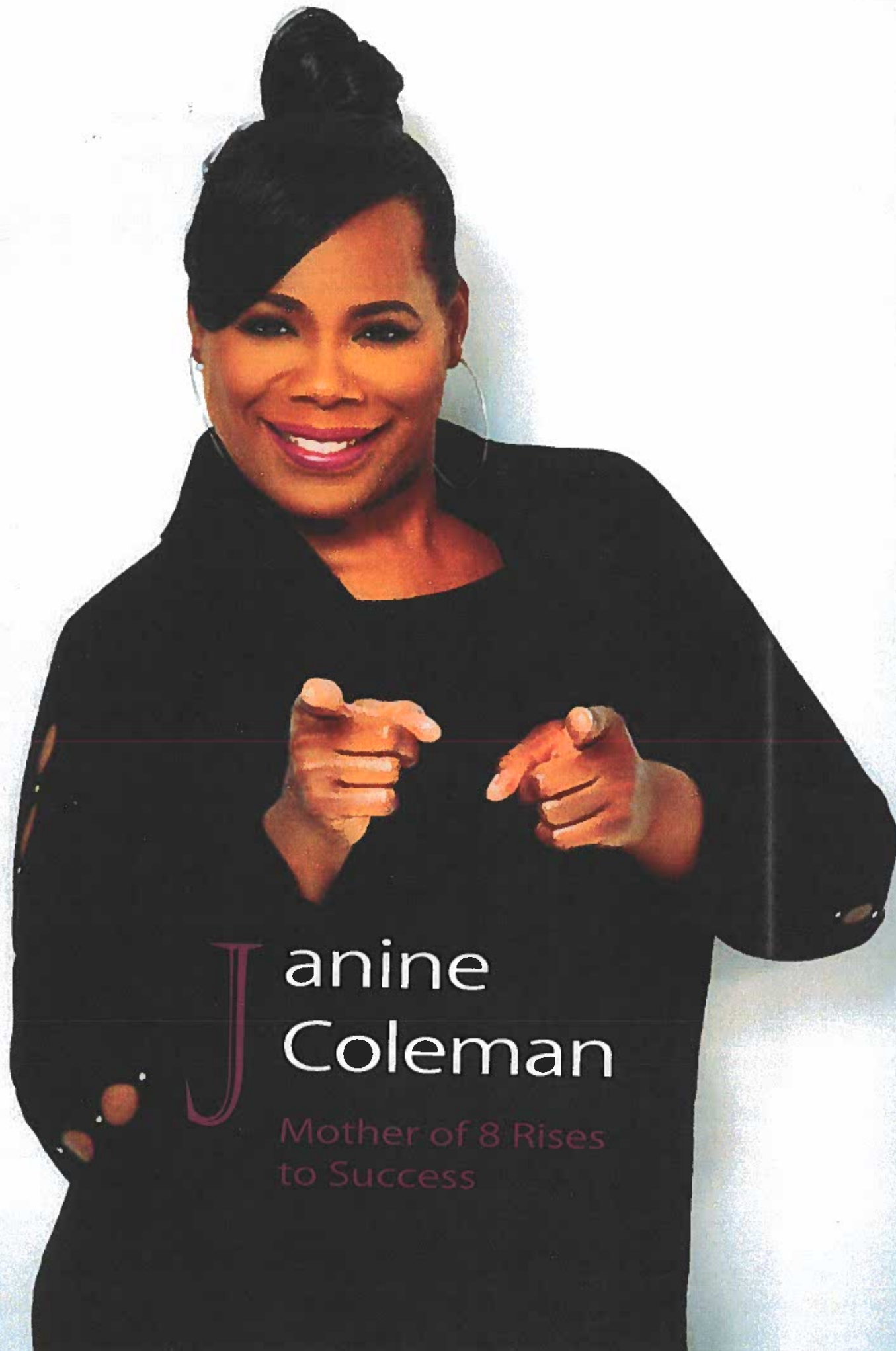

In June of 2006, she received her Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.

On her way to happy ever after, Janine would later land a job with the federal government where her world would stabilize until she was fired in 2017! But this job loss was different! A few months prior to being terminated she had a dream where she heard the Spirit of God speak to her and say, "If you take care of my people, I will take care of you." Not only did Janine hear the voice of God speak, she also had God fearing Grand Parents who never stopped believing in her. Grandma said, "Baby, never say I

and can't in the same sentence, you can do anything you want, just keep God with you and never forget where you come from."

Armed with a word of assurance from God and Grandma, Janine took the leap of faith and decided to market her gift of cooking and Coleman's Kitchen was born. In February 2019, she was selected and awarded a 2019 Dream Grant by the Department of Small and Local Business Development (DSLBD) in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00). On her way with a multi-million dollar vision, Janine has already made history in the food industry of entrepreneur in Washington D.C. as the first known African American woman to open a REAL Soul Food Carryout business in the area.
